
## UO App:


The app opens with a graphically pleasing opening screen, and then loads into a menu of categories to shop.

Before buying the top I always check reviews so I scrolled down the page a bit to find the reviews on the shirt.









Unlike the urban outfitter's app, the brandy Melville website homepage is already open to a catalog of their popular items at the moment.
